Hong Kong Junior Rapid Chess Championships 2019

Age Group: U7, U9, U11, U13, U18

Organised by the Hong Kong Juniors Chess Club & Sponsored by Hong Kong International School

The Hong Kong Junior Rapid Chess Championships 2019 will take place on **5 May 2019**.

Type of tournament

- ✧ There will be five age groups, U7 (born in 2012 or after), U9 (born in 2010 or after), U11 (born in 2008 or after), U13 (born in 2006 or after), U18 (born in 2001 or after).
- ✧ There will be 7 rounds for each age group. The time limits (each player) per game will be 25 minutes for the age groups U18, U13, U11 & U9; and 10 minutes for the age group U7.

Particulars

Date: Sunday, 5 May 2019

Time: Age groups **U9, U11, U13 & U18** from 9.00 am to 5.00 pm; **U7** from 1.00 pm to 5.00 pm

Venue: High School Cafeteria, Hong Kong International School, 1 Red Hill Road, Tai Tam, HK.

Prize: Medals for the top six players if there are more than 20 entries in the respective age group. Otherwise medals for the top three only.

Entry fee: \$200

Certificate: Certificate of participation will be issued by post SUBJECT to payment of \$50 at time of registration.

Registration: Registration must be made on-line at www.hkjuniorchess.org, and the registration will be closed by end of **18 April 2019**. Late entry or walk-in will not be considered. Payment is also to be made on-line and registration is not considered complete until payment is made. Once registration is completed with payment made, Paypal® will send you a receipt by email, which will serve as confirmation of your registration. No refund for withdrawal after registration. If you do not receive the receipt, it is very likely that your registration has been unsuccessful or you have provided a wrong email address and you should check your credit card. Please bring along a copy of the receipt in case verification is required. The player list will be automatically uploaded on Hong Kong Juniors Chess Club website once your registration (together with payment) is successful.

Lunch: There will be a short break for lunch at about 1.00 p.m. The Starbucks on Main Entrance will be open from 8:00am to 3:30pm. There is a supermarket in front of High School Main Entrance.
