## Hong Kong Inter-School Chess Championships 2020

Organised by Hong Kong Juniors Chess Club & Sponsored by King George V School

The Hong Kong Inter-School Chess Championships 2020, organized by the Hong Kong Juniors Chess Club and sponsored by King George V School, will take place on Saturday and Sunday, **9 and 10 May 2020**.

### Type of tournament

- ❖ There will be 3 divisions: one for secondary schools, one for primary schools and a special one for primary school Y1 to Y3 students only. All members of a school team shall be students of that school.
- ❖ This is a team event. There will be 7 rounds with 4 boards each round.
- ❖ A school may enter any number of teams but it is only eligible for a maximum of one team prize as well as a maximum of two board prizes on each board order in each division.
- ❖ Time limits per game will be 1 hour for each player in the secondary division; 25 minutes in the primary division and 15 minutes for Y1-Y3 division.
- ❖ Players in the secondary division shall keep score of the games until his/her clock has less than 5 minutes.

### Organizational details

- Date:** **Secondary Division:** Saturday and Sunday, 9 & 10 May 2020  
**Primary Division and Primary Y1-Y3 Division:** Sunday, 10 May 2020
- Time:** 9:00 am to 4:30 pm except that Primary Y1-Y3 Division is from 11:00 am - 4:30 pm
- Venue:** Hall for Primary Y1-Y3 Division & Primary Division, Senior Rooms (SSC3-5) for Secondary Division, King George V School, 2 Tin Kwong Road, Homantin, Kowloon, HK (九龍何文田天光道2號)
- Lunch:** 1:00pm to 1:30pm. Main Canteen open from 10:30am - 3:30pm on Sunday only, 10 May. Serving hot food & drinks. Secondary students need to bring their own lunch and drink on Saturday, 9 May.
- Prize:** Trophies for the first, second and third teams plus a medal for each team member of the winning teams in every division. There will also be board prizes for the top 3 players on each board order. The number of board prizes will be increased to 6 if there are more than 20 entries in that division.
- Entry fee:** **\$600** per team for early registration on or **before 3 April 2020**; and **\$1000** per team for those who miss the early bird rate.
- Registration:** Registration will be closed by 23:59 on 29 April 2020. Registration together with the payment must be made on-line at [www.hkjuniorchess.org](http://www.hkjuniorchess.org). Registration without making the appropriate payment will not be considered as completed. Once registration is completed, Paypal® will send you a receipt by email, which will serve as confirmation of your registration. Your team will also be added to the registered list which will appear on [www.hkjuniorchess.org](http://www.hkjuniorchess.org). There is no refund for withdrawal after registration. If you do not receive the Paypal receipt, it is very likely that your registration has been unsuccessful or you have provided a wrong email address and you should check your credit card and contact the organizer. Please bring along a copy of the receipt as verification may be required.
